# Why Inman?

## The Population

---

**83,000**  
people within a 7-mile  
radius of downtown

**40 years**  
median age of the  
population

## The Need

---

### Growth

- Population in the city and surrounding areas have increased significantly in the past 10 years, especially in Spartanburg, Boiling Springs, and Wellford.
- Many new businesses have moved into the downtown area, attempting a revitalization.

### Church Landscape

- 72.5% of people in this area have no involvement in a religious congregation or community. That represents over 60,000 people and the number is increasing.
- By planting in Inman, we hope to reach that community as well as the 5 or 6 surrounding communities by providing the residents with a Baptist, discipleship-driven, elder-led church where none currently exists.

### Community Engagement

- Multiple schools in the area have asked for aid in student mentoring and teacher support and are open to church partnership.
- There is an "athletics culture" in the community that pre-existing ministries in our church like Runner's Camp can easily step into.

## Our Mission

# Our Strategy

## Corporate Worship

- The Word preached (expository, Christ-centered).
- The Word read, prayed, and practiced (liturgy and corporate elements).
- The Word sung (congregational worship through song).

## Missional Community

- **Family Meals:** small groups gathered weekly for shared meals, fellowship in the Scriptures, and prayer)
- **Cell Groups:** weekly gathering with one or two other believers to discuss the scriptures and pray together for the sake of spiritual maturity
- **Community Outreach:** Regular, intentional efforts to meet the needs of others and demonstrate the love of Jesus)

## Teaching and Training

- Core Classes (Regular opportunities for supplemental teaching on relevant topics in light of the Scriptures)
- Men's and Women's Equip (Regular gatherings to facilitate authentic relationships and equip men and women to pursue godliness and biblical faithfulness in their daily lives)
- Children's and Students' Ministry (Regular gatherings and special events to teach the Scriptures to our children and students, cultivate healthy peer relationships, and provide them with opportunities for gospel ministry and community outreach)

## Leadership



### Danny Seay

Danny and his wife Ashlyn have been married since 2017. They have two children, Emerson (4) and Elloree (2) and are expecting a third in late Fall 2024. They have been members of Christ Fellowship Northwest since 2018, where Danny has served on staff for the past 6 years. Currently Danny serves as their pastor of missions and worship. Danny holds a Bachelor of Arts in Intercultural Studies from North Greenville University and a Master of Divinity in Great Commission Studies from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

### Fall 2025 and Onward

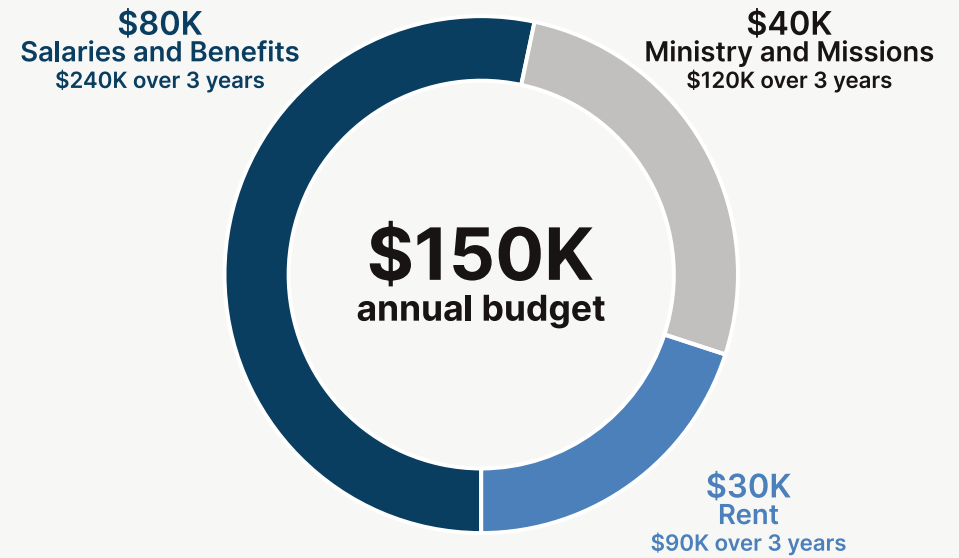
- Publicly launch as Christ Fellowship Inman

## Financial Goal

# \$500K

\$150K 3-year annual budget +  
\$50K in start up costs



## Monthly Breakdown

Broken up monthly over the next 3 years, our church needs just under **\$14,000 each month** in order to meet our goal. However, through partnerships with our sending church, Christ Fellowship Northwest, the South Carolina Baptist Convention, and the projected tithes and offerings of our core team members, we expect to bring in \$248,000 to our goal already. This reduces our monthly need to around **\$7,000 for the next 3 years**.
